Art on Wheels Program
Guidelines for Submission

- ❖ Send a photo of the art in jpg format to sherry.gabriele@hawaiiantel.net. The email should include the width of the art, a phone number and an email address. The height has to be 11 inches in order to fit in the track above the bus windows.
- ❖ The photo will be circulated by email to Commissioners for voting.
- ❖ If accepted by the Commission, the artist must place the print on a very thin backing and have it laminated. Please check the size of the track frames on the bus, if there are any questions.
- ❖ The finished piece must be flexible enough to bend to accommodate the bus' curvature.
- ❖ The size allowable is 11 inches high (required), by up to 25 inches wide (maximum width).
- ❖ The piece can be titled and display the artist's name or it may show the name of a nonprofit organization, with a limitation of two out of the three choices.
- ❖ The artists of selected artwork will be invited to deliver the finished print to the County Department of Transportation, David Trask Building, Kaohu Street, Wailuku.
- ❖ All submissions must have a telephone number and email address on the back if the artist wants it returned. No guarantee can be made of the print's safety or its return.
- ❖ Artists are welcome to check out any of the 13 public buses which crisscross Maui daily. A schedule is available online at <http://www.co.maui.hi.us/>.
- ❖ All questions should be directed to the email address above, since bus drivers have no information about the program, and they cannot accept any artwork.
