County Invites Artists to Participate in Bus Art Program

WAILUKU, Maui, Hawaii- Local artists are invited to submit art for consideration for a new program, "Art on Wheels," which will display art on the County's 13 buses, the County of Maui Department of Housing and Human Concerns (DHHC) announced today.

The brainchild of Mayor Charmaine Tavares, the displays will be administered by DHHC through the Maui County Commission on Culture & the Arts and in conjunction with the County of Maui Department of Transportation. The art is expected to be placed on buses later this spring, and changed out on a quarterly basis.

Art may be submitted by individuals or by a non-profit group, and all pieces must be two-dimensional and flexible enough to fit the buses' curved interior display area above the windows. Size is limited to 11 inches high; width may vary up to 25 inches. Artwork should be a laminated reproduction placed on a thin backing.
